Purchasers who register interest prior to the sale will receive a digital copy of the sale catalogue. Please print this and bring it along with you on the day. A limited number of printed catalogues will be available on site.

Purchasers will be supplied with the vendor's account number and will be required to show proof of payment having been made before removing any sheep from site. Please come prepared appropriately to make payment.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/SALE

1. Entries must be accompanied by entry fees. Deposit to Hawkes Bay Branch account: 01-0778-0029277-00 Please use "NI Sheep Sale" and your name as reference.
2. Vendors must be members of the Black and Coloured Sheep Breeders Association of New Zealand.
3. Vendors may enter a maximum of one ram per breed per age group.
4. Entry fees: MA ewes \$8, MA rams \$15, 2th ewes \$8, 2th rams \$15, ewe lambs \$5.
5. Please give details of registered stock on entry form.
6. Pedigrees (where known) should go back three generations.
7. All sheep offered for sale will be in natural condition in accordance with BCSBANZ rules. Buttonhole crutch is permissible but britch wool must be left on.
8. Any heterozygous ewes entered must have an ear tag. The ewe's sire and dam must be listed and the colour genetics identified.
9. All sheep offered for sale must have been shorn prior to Labour Weekend (27 October) 2025.
10. An Animal Status Declaration (ASD) must accompany all stock to sale. Please provide a single ASD with all animals listed by pen number. ASD forms will be available on site.
11. Only sheep entered in the sale will be permitted on the grounds on the day of the sale.
12. Sheep will be inspected in the pens for wool and conformation prior to the sale.
13. All rams must have current certification as Brucellosis-free which must be provided when registering for sale. All rams will be inspected by a veterinarian on site as well.
14. Any sheep not passed by the veterinarian or inspectors must be removed from the pens.
15. Selling order will be as catalogued.
16. Registered sheep will be offered first in each section.
17. Sale will be conducted GST exclusive.
18. Every lot will be the responsibility of the purchaser at the fall of the hammer.
19. All sales of passed-in stock to be directed through the auctioneer.
20. For non-members, payment is to be made direct to vendor on the day, and proof of payment supplied to the on-site administrators.
21. For members, a list of purchases and required payments will be sent after the sale. Payment to be made immediately on receipt of list.
22. No sheep may be removed from the yards without a delivery docket, obtainable after payment.
23. All livestock must arrive and leave in transport that complies with animal welfare regulations for suitable restraint and wind protection.
24. The Sale Committee reserves the right to alter any of the above at any time.
