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**FEES:**

**Registration:** \$25.00 to register a flock, plus \$1.00 per head for all sheep registered.  
**Inspection:** \$1.00 per head for all sheep submitted, plus travel at 50c per kilometer, which can be shared if inspector sees more than one flock.

**REGULATIONS:**

A complete set of rules governing the registered flocks is printed in the current Flock Book. Please read them carefully.

**INSPECTION:**

- 5. Breeding records for flocks must have been kept and available for inspection.
- 6. Each flock to be inspected by two inspectors. Minimum fleece length at time of inspection: Merino (2cm), Fine Wool (3cm) and Strong Wool (5cm).
- 7. All sheep inspected for registration must be wearing numbered metal or plastic eartags with flock prefix, year of birth and sheep's number as a permanent form of identification. Sheep without these tags will not be inspected.
